

# SUPPLIER CODE OF CONDUCT

#### Purpose

At Mannaz, our purpose is to **move what truly matters** – for the people and organizations we serve and for the world at large. Sustainability in all aspects is our commitment. We believe inclusion, diversity, psychological safety, and securing a sustainable green future are key drivers for business operations that are financially sound and future fit.

Since Mannaz A/S is committed to conducting business ethically and sustainably, we expect our suppliers to adhere to the same principles. Our Supplier Code of Conduct outlines the minimum standards and practices we require from all our suppliers to ensure that all parties involved operate responsibly & in line with legal regulations aligned with our company's values.

#### Compliance with laws and regulations

Suppliers must comply with all applicable local, national, EU and international laws and regulations, including but not limited to labor laws, environmental regulations, and anti-corruption laws.

**Key standards** and conventions we adhere to include:

- UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights
- International Bill of Human Rights
- International Labour Organization Conventions
- Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact.

### LABOR & HUMAN RIGHTS

- Fair Wages and Working hours: Suppliers must provide fair wages and benefits that meet or exceed legal standards. Working hours should comply with local laws and not be excessive.
- No Child Labor: Suppliers must not employ individuals below the legal working age.
- No Forced Labor: Suppliers must not use forced or involuntary labor.
- Non-Discrimination: Suppliers must provide a workplace free from discrimination based on race, gender, age, religion, or any other protected characteristic, guided by the relevant EU regulations and international guidelines on nondiscrimination, equal opportunities, and fair wages in procurement decisions.



# HEALTH & SAFETY

Suppliers must provide a safe and healthy working environment. This includes taking proactive measures to prevent accidents and injuries and ensuring that workers have access to necessary safety equipment and training.

# ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTICES

Suppliers must comply with all industryspecific environmental laws and regulations.

They should strive to minimize their environmental impact in in all material & relevant aspects of their business operations by:

- Reducing greenhouse gas emissions in line with general best practices & Mannaz Travel Guidelines (as described in Mannaz Code of Conduct, Appendix 1),
- Reducing waste generation to mitigate land & water pollution and help preserve clean water reserves,
- Safeguarding natural systems from accidental pollution and hazardous materials,
- Conserving energy resources and use sustainable solutions to create positive change,
- Promoting sustainable products reuse & responsible disposal at the end of its lifecycle.

In Mannaz, we will prioritise procurement from suppliers adopting or improving own

environmental practices including some or all of those mentioned above, depending on industry & materiality factors.

# ETHICAL BUSINESS PRACTICES

- Anti-Corruption: Suppliers must not engage in any form of corruption, including bribery, extortion, or embezzlement
- Fraud: Suppliers must not perform any intentional acts of illegal, unethical or inappropriate behavior.
- Fair Competition: Suppliers must engage in fair business practices and avoid any activities that restrict competition.
- Conflict of interest: Suppliers must ensure compliance to prevent anticompetitive practices like bid-rigging or price-fixing.
- Information Security: Suppliers must implement measures to prevent breaches of physical & digital data.
- Confidentiality: Suppliers must protect the confidentiality of all proprietary information shared by Mannaz A/S.



#### Monitoring and Compliance

Mannaz A/S reserves the right to monitor and audit suppliers to ensure compliance with this *Code of Conduct*. Suppliers are expected to cooperate fully with any such audits and provide necessary documentation.

#### **Reporting Violations**

Suppliers must report any violations of this Code of Conduct to Mannaz A/S. We will investigate all reports and take appropriate action.

# Continuous Improvement

Suppliers are encouraged to continuously improve their practices and align with the principles outlined in this Code of Conduct, Mannaz Procurement Policy & all other relevant regulations & standards.
